



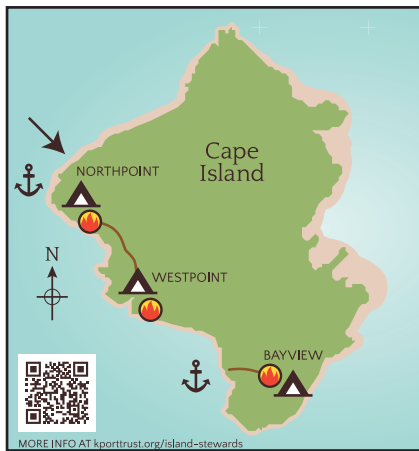

Please contact us if you come across any injured seals, birds, or other wildlife.

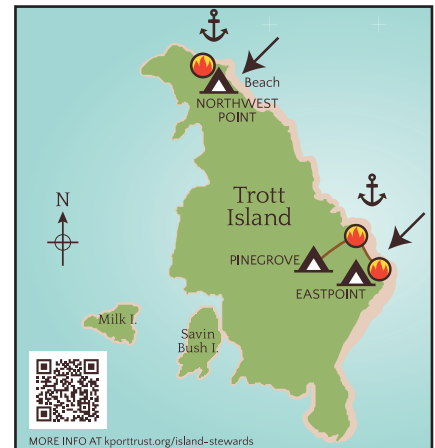

Visiting the Islands

*Camping and fire permits must be filed
at the Kennebunkport Police Station, 101 Main Street.*

TRAVEL AND CAMPING

- Travelling in small groups is best, as it protects fragile environments and promotes sharing among visitors. Please respect the camping capacity guidelines for each island, as that will allow others to enjoy them too.
- Camping is allowed only on established campsites. If the campsites are already in use, try and share an existing site, or bivouac on smooth granite, sand, or gravel. Please naturalize the site afterwards, and leave no trace.
- Please plan to stay no more than two nights. This will allow others to use the site and reduce the impact of longer stays.

MINIMIZE CAMPFIRE IMPACTS

- We highly recommend no fires on the islands because of the inherent risks and the lack of sufficient driftwood for fuel. Many of the trees have been damaged and lost due to cutting; they will not come back. The tree decay is vital to soil replenishment of the island environment and ecosystem. Camp stoves are the preferred method of cooking. If a fire permit is granted, please utilize designated sites and bring your own firewood.
- Please do not attempt to burn trash, cans, bottles, foil, food scraps, etc.
- Do not cut or clear vegetation, dead or alive, for any purpose.

DISPOSE OF WASTE PROPERLY

- Please carry out all solid human waste and toilet paper to the mainland for proper disposal, as well as all trash – your own and any you find.

RESPECT WILDLIFE

- Please enjoy wildlife from a distance, giving wide berth to nesting seabirds, eagles, osprey, rafting eiders, and seals.
- Please leave pets at home.

BE CONSIDERATE OF OTHERS

- Help us protect the island experience for all by developing a sharing ethic and preserving the peace and quiet of these special places.
- Please be considerate of others who live and work in the area.
- Cape Porpoise is a working harbor. Please keep this in mind.
